SCHOOLS CRICKET

The start of the season was delayed by a Covid-related Government prohibition on all inter-school sport that continued for several weeks after the same people had been allowed to participate in inter-club cricket. In the very short period of term time left to us we were able to organise three knock-out cups at Senior, Intermediate (U-14 and U15) and Junior (U12 and U13) levels which attracted a total of 43 entries. Remarkably fine weather in late May and June allowed 69 fixtures to be completed with only one rain rearrangement. RBAI and Campbell College emerged as the strongest schools, with the former eventually taking home all three trophies.

Despite our best efforts, no representative matches could be arranged. The MCC tour in June was cancelled while the absence of any inter-school cricket in Leinster prevented the Southern Schools from being able to field a team. The possibility of a tour to Glasgow in August was kept alive as long as possible but ultimately fell victim to the enduring levels of Covid infection on both sides of the North Channel and the associated restrictions affecting sport that had been retained in Scotland.
